G

Lisa: With so many of us turning to caravanning as a safe socially distant way of holiday did you know that the large refillable gas cylinders need to be returned to the company that supplied the gas originally if you no longer want to make use of it. What about H Alison?

H

Alison: Hard plastics you know the type that crack rather than flex and bend such as unwanted children's toys. Although they are plastic they cannot go in your silver recycling bin they need to go to a charity shop if they are good enough or the household waste recycling centre or for smaller items your black household waste bin. Items such as plant pots can also be returned to some garden centres but check with them first. Lisa how about letter I?

Lisa: A really common item that can appear in waste bins are inhalers. These need to be returned to participating pharmacies. Another item that so many of us use for home printing is ink cartridges. There are many charities which welcome unwanted ink cartridges. You can also find local stores who will refill ink cartridges so you can re-use them. Alternatively, you can take them to a household waste recycling centre.
