P

Alison: With winter lockdowns, many of us have taken to home DIY, so any leftover paint you don't have a need for anymore need to go to your local Household Recycling Centre. Another time-consuming task, many of us may have turned to, is sorting out old photographs! These actually cannot be recycled because they have a plastic film covering, so they need to be disposed of in your black general household waste bin. What about Q Lisa?

Q I have Quilts, Duvets and Pillows. Unfortunately not all charity shops will take these and they can't go in any of your household bins and need to go to your local Household Waste Recycling centre.

Lisa: Alison how about letter R?

R

Alison: Well after watching 'Rubbish Dump Britain', let's mention RUBBLE! This cannot go in any of your household waste bins and needs to go to your local Household Waste Recycling Centre. There is a small charge for disposing of rubble, so best to phone ahead and check or go to cheshireeast.gov.uk/waste and recycling. For larger volumes it may be better to hire a skip.
